The homeowners wanted to add to the rear of the home in a way that highlighted the lush beauty of the backyard but also permitted natural light to penetrate the central hall on both floors. An additional goal was to give those entering the front hall a glimpse of the backyard. To achieve those goals, the southfacing rear facade, as well as the east and west-facing walls, were heavily fenestrated. The addition of three Marvin Clad French Doors and several large windows allowed the entirety of the house to be filled with ample amounts of light.
